

Fire Department

The Frankenlust Township Fire Department was started in 1976. Originally the department stored the Fire Apparatus in Mr. Leinberger's barn until the current station and township hall was built. Over the years the department has grown from a department with just a 2-seat fire engine and a converted milk tanker to a fully modern department. Currently the Frankenlust Township Fire Department has a 2010 Rosenbauer Rescue Pumper, 2001 Darley Engine, 2000 Ford Brush Truck, and a 2012 Ford Rescue Truck. The Department is fully modernized with foam capability on 3 vehicles, 2 sets of Jaws of Life, as well as the most up to date equipment possible. We are currently staffed with 20 firefighters with several members EMT trained and also several with Paramedic certification.

2017 Review

Your Department is currently staffed with twenty firefighters, including two paramedics, four emergency medical technicians, and five first responders. We responded to 382 calls in 2017. The calls were as follows:

- 16 fires**, which include 4 structure fires, 5 vehicle fires, 3 brush/grass fires, 4 misc. fires
- 260 medical/rescue calls**, which include 45 motor vehicle accidents
- 20 hazardous condition calls**, which include carbon monoxide alarms and power lines or poles down or on fire
- 24 service calls**, which include water problems or leaks and citizen assists/public service requests
- 62 good intent calls**, which include cancelled in route or false alarms
