**Resolution to adopt an alternative language for the millage ballot on August 4, 2026, Primary Election.**

**Motion by LaPan/Stothard to adopt Resolution number 2026-06, to renew the existing millage in an amount not to exceed 1.5 mills(\$1.50 on each one thousand dollars of taxable value as reduced by Headlee to \$1.4728 limitation( as provided for by Section 6, Article IX of the 1963 Constitution of Michigan on all real and personal property within the township and levy it for a period of ten (10) years to be collected in December, 2028- through 2037, inclusive for police and fire protection which will raise an estimated \$290,075.00 in the first year the millage is levied? Discussion.**
