The 29th Annual Kiamichi Big Buck Classic turned out to be a great hunt, and the quality of deer harvested was amazing. Bob would have been ecstatic!

The Grand Prize winner of the 29th Annual Classic was Bob Wenrich from Adamstown, Pennsylvania. Bob kicked off the Classic by harvesting a massive 11 point buck that scored 161 4/8. His deer was taken on the first day of the Classic. Joe Howell out of York, Pennsylvania took top honors on day two of the Classic with a fantastic 9 point scoring 139 4/8. Andrew Hendricks from Taylors, South Carolina placed first on the final day with an outstanding 10 point buck that scored 152 5/8.

The second place winners were Saben Emery from Ovilla, Texas with a very impressive 11 point that scored 148 4/8, Scott Cleaver out of Crestwood, Kentucky who harvested a super 10 point scoring 135, and Kurt Durette from Cocoa, Florida rounded out the 2nd place honors with a really nice 9 point buck scoring 129 1/8.

KBBC ENTRY FEE

The Hunt Fee is \$2,860.00 plus license (\$300.00 license fee, or \$100.00 for 15-17 years old) and includes 4 nights lodging, catered buffet breakfast, sack lunches and 2 banquet dinners at the SE Expo Center. You may deduct \$80 from the entry fee if two paid hunters share accommodations.

A \$450 deposit is required to secure your entry in the 2019 Kiamichi Big Buck Classic, with an additional payment of \$1,000 due July 1, 2019. The remaining balance will be due upon arrival at the 2019 hunt. *All deposits and payments are non-refundable.*

KIAMICHI BIG BUCK CLASSIC RULES & REGULATIONS

- Stand selections will be made by sealed drawing on a daily basis.
- Hunters must stay within their territory boundaries.
- Hunters must wear an orange cap and vest. The Cap only, will be furnished by Oklahoma Game Hunting, Inc.
- All racks will be scored non-typical with no deductions using the Boone and Crockett scoring systems. All racks will be scored by an official scorer, all decisions will be final.
- In case of a tie, the lesser amount of deductions will determine the winner.
- All hunters are subject to disqualification by Oklahoma Game Hunting, Inc., and must be willing to submit to polygraph testing.
- NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS will be permitted during hunting hours.
- Times will be designated for guides to pick up their hunters at the lodge each morning. Delays due to tardiness will not be allowed.
- When a hunter kills a deer (regardless of size), that deer is his or hers for the hunt.
- The minimum age requirement is 15 years of age. All minors must be accompanied by parent or guardian.
- In addition to the rules of Oklahoma Game Hunting, Inc., the rules of the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife apply.
- In case of a broken antler or head shot, judges will make the final decision.
- Rattling horns, calls and lures, if used, must be within 100 yards of stand.
- All hunters must stay within 300 yards of stand (check with your guide).
- Hunters will leave their stand areas free of all trash and debris.
- If a hunter wounds a deer, when that hunter personally stops looking for that deer and leaves the woods, that deer is disqualified.
- On the last day of the hunt if a hunter has a buck wounded and the hunter or guide is not physically touching that deer by 7:00 p.m., that deer will be disqualified from the hunt.
- Before entering any Oklahoma Game Hunting vehicle, every hunter will be asked to check his or her rifle in order to make sure it is unloaded.

We feel that quality leases, stand placement and food enhancements are the most important aspects in harvesting trophy whitetail. Starting very early in the season, we begin filling up the corn feeders and preparing the food plots. We have implemented additional minerals and food enhancements to hold and attract deer, as well as to improve the health and antler growth of the herd. As the days pass, we begin to pattern the deer to determine the best stands to use in the Classic.



We spend a lot of time out in the field doing everything possible to improve on each and every stand. This hunt is not just a three day event to us. It is basically 365 days of planning, organizing, and preparing for the opening day of rifle season. We really do appreciate all of your comments and suggestions. You spend the time in these stands, and we want to make that time enjoyable and successful.

All of our leases are hunted exclusively for this three day event. We reserve this right in order to insure quality deer management. These ranches, along with our present leases, have the potential of producing trophy class bucks.
