## WHAT IS A CRIME & NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH PROGRAM?

*It is a program for which helps the prevention of crime. It enlists active participants in cooperation with law enforcement agencies to reduce crime in the community.*

## Solutions for lowering crime in your neighborhood

### WHAT DOES IT INVOLVE

- Residents getting together to get to know one another and working together in a program with local law enforcement of mutual assistance.
- Training residents to recognize and report suspicious activities in their neighborhoods; and
- Implementation of crime prevention techniques such as self and home security, communicating with law enforcement dispatch, and other means to help deputies investigate.
- Residents are the eyes and ears for their law enforcement agency.

### WHY NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH?

- Nationally, millions of crimes are committed each and every year. This numbers are growing.
- There cant be a law enforcement officer on every corner, so citizen involvement is essential to combat crime.

### FIRST
