Junior SAV cadets will learn about a law enforcement environment and provide community service alongside a seasoned Sheriff's Auxiliary Officers.

The program helps provide direction and leadership skills for youth. Youth gain a sense of service to the community with outreach opportunities. They also experience being part of a team in a positive atmosphere.

All Jr. SAV's are provided the same training, some of which include first aid / CPR, radio communications, patrol techniques, defensive tactics, and administration skills that all the other members receive.

Whether the youth's future is in law enforcement or not, this gives them a sense of purpose with positive leadership that will last them a lifetime.

### REQUIREMENTS:

1. Be between the ages of 13-18
2. Have at least a "C" or 3.0 grade point average on the last report card issued.
3. Be able to pass background check.
