(2) Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. (3) For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. (4) When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

7. Explain: “Set your affection on things above.”

8. Why are believers instructed to: “seek those things” and “Set your affection on those things.” What is the difference?

9. How does this determine the believers’ priorities and consecration.

10. What are the differences between “the things which are above” and “things on the earth.”

11. How does seeking and setting, help the believers’ consecration?

12. Explain: “For ye are dead.”

13. Explain: “your life is hid with Christ in God.”

14. What does this mean: “Christ, who is our life.”

15. What is the purpose of this statement: “then shall ye also appear with him in glory.”
