

Prayer Squares 4 1/2 in

Fabric squares with pictures, sayings, flowers, religious, angels, cross, dove etc

CUT:


Batting first



Backing- right side up




Square- right side down



SEW:

Stitch a 1/4 in seam around the edges leaving a 2in opening

backstitch when starting and stopping



TURN:

Flip the square inside out- put your finger between both fabric pieces and turn
Push out the four corners until they are pointed (use a pencil but easy does it)

INSERT:

Place the small cross inside the 2in opening

PRESS:

Place a piece of iron on adhesive tape (Heat & Bond 1/4 or 1/2)

Cut 2 1/4 in and insert it in the fold- then IRON- hold down the iron until the bond is set

PRAYER TIE:


Using embroidery floss place a tie on the top of the square
placement depends on the scenery of the fabric

Thread floss into large eye needle

double the floss if it is too thin

Pull through from front to back and back to front

Ties should be no longer than the square



Prayers of intention for those who need our prayers should be said at this point while making the knot

Note* It takes time to get each one the same but it is worth the time and effort
