Through the generosity of each of you, our donors **2,671 outfits** were received, and hand delivered to the children. The following is a breakdown of the distribution details.

- 1,081 boy's complete outfits
- 1,359 girl's complete outfits
- 202 infant and toddler outfits
- 2,892 care kits
- 2,642 pair of shoes to children
- 5 pair of shoes provide to parents walking to work everyday
- 2,892 Back to School Packs
- 832 Back Packs
- 27 tons of food
- 18 tons of paper products & diapers
- 2,892 Dolls, stuffed Animals & toys
