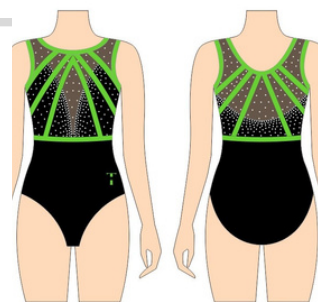
Rubbish
