

Code of Conduct for Parents / Guardians

This Code of Conduct is an unsigned agreement between the Parent, Carer, Visitor and Tumbles Academy of Gymnastics

- It is essential that all parents, guardians and visitors to the club take great care when parking or "dropping off". Please observe the double yellow lines and the Red Zones (see Tumbles Parking Policy) where there should be NO PARKING at any time.
- 2. Ensure that your child is appropriately dressed and has plenty to drink (water only) and has visited the toilet prior to their lesson.
- 3. Jewellery is prohibited and long hair should be tied back.
- 4. Please ensure your child's contact details are up to date on Coacha and notify Tumbles of any disability or medical condition in order that our coaching team can provide the correct level of support/guidance.
- 5. Ensure that your child attends on time and always collect your child promptly at the end of a session. Please inform the coach at the beginning of the session if the usual person is not collecting your child.
- 6. Use appropriate channels to voice any grievances against any of the coaching staff, other parents or other gymnasts in your child's team: email or phone calls ONLY to the Head Coach or Welfare Officer. NO texting or social media.
- 7. Any abusive or threatening behaviour towards any Tumbles member or guest will result in permanent exclusion for the club.
- 8. Be aware of the Emergency Evacuation Policy.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results. Set a good example by
 recognising good sportsmanship. Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their
 sport.
- 10. It is important for parents and carers to make sure any persons dropping or collecting their children are aware of this policy.
