Comrades,

Veterans Day originated as "Armistice Day" on **November 11**, 1919, the first anniversary of the end of <u>World War I</u>. Congress passed a resolution in 1926 for an annual observance, and November 11 became a national holiday beginning in 1938. Unlike <u>Memorial Day</u>, Veterans Day pays tribute to all American veterans—living or dead—but especially gives thanks to living veterans who served their country honorably during war or peacetime.


