Call to Order: 6:12pm

New Items: Langdon Tax Levy, November 15th Joint Use Committee Meeting – has been updated to November 21st.

1. Communications Committee Update: The Share Point File system is all ready to go if you have documents to add please upload them. The Communications team will put them in the proper folder to make the system consistent.
 - Quarterly Newsletter – They are focusing on the FAQs and expanding on those. They will email the people who have expressed interested via our sign-up sheet. They will also be printed and left in Coffee Shops, Restaurants, Hairdressers and the Credit Union. It will also be printed and placed in the water bill from Langdon Waterworks. Mail Chimp will be used to send out the newsletter.
 - The website has been updated with the Sign unveiling picture.
 - Chrissy has set up a You Tube page. First item placed on there is the Binnie 3-D rendering of the site.
 - Chrissy has also created a package that we can use to send out in the email to potential donors after our initial visit. It consists of a copy of the Business Case, the Newsletter, the picture of the diamonds and the Case for support.
2. Langdon Tax Levy: Al had some concerns about how it has changed from the last time he was in office and how we would like it addressed in the future. It was mentioned that in past recreation studies residents felt they would be ok even if it was increased or doubled from its current rate.

3. Fundraising Committee Update:

- Donation Report – We have been asked by potential donors what has been contributed in the past. A document was created to show those individuals what has been presented before and how much has already been contributed to the current project. It was discussed to have it broken down even more to donations given to the full 45 acre site and then donations that have come forward just for the current 20 acre site in Phase 1.
- Agrium Donation – corrie was presented with a \$5,000 donation from Agrium.
- Case For Support – this is ready to go and can be sent to the printer for hard copies to be made. Looks great with updated content and picture. Addition of the NBCFB logo was recommended.
- Recognition Opportunities: Chrissy has updated this to show the current opportunities that we have available if donors are interested.

4. NBCFB (members appointed by council): This was done in the past for the County to recognize you as an “official” group you would present the county with member you would like to sit on the board and they would appoint those members. We currently have 2 members appointed to the board. One has moved and resigned from the board so we are looking to fill that position.

- We are also looking for clarification from Corwin on how we get the County the names we would like to appoint or put up for consideration. Clarification still needed on this.
