Happy New Year Patriots 2024

I hope each of you had a happy holiday with time to reflect on new beginnings. If you were fortunate enough to have attended the Christmas luncheon that Sam Silver, Marion Gardner, and Kathy Hussey arranged, you may already have your New Year Resolutions. Our guest speaker Sonny McAfee, Llano District Attorney, gave his thoughts on Stephen Covey's book "The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People". His perspective of the principle of 90/10 where 10% of life is made up of what happens to

you and 90% of life is decided by how you react, made me take inventory of my own life. It prompted a personal reminder that happiness really is a choice. One of my favorite principles of Covey's book states both happiness and unhappiness are proactive choices.
