**Crop Share/Subscription** - Crop shares provide customers with veggies throughout the growing season. You may choose to make one payment of \$480 at the beginning of season. Subscriptions are available with 3 installments of \$160 each. The first installment is due with application and applied to MAY/JUNE. The second installment is due by June 20th for JULY/AUGUST. The third installment is due August 20 for SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER. Additional vegetables and products will be available as we extend the growing season and expand our offerings. Unused funds remain in your account and can be used at any time.

**Work Share** - Join our group of people passionate about growing and eating healthy vegetables. Work shares vary from working four hours a week to utilizing our farm as your home garden. **\$200 (Due by April 1.)**
