- Social Neuroscience & Empathy Circuits
- → Mirror neurons in the brain fire both when we act and when we see others act—connection is neurologically embedded.

 (Iacoboni, 2009)
 - Heart-Field Synchrony
- → The electromagnetic field of the human heart can synchronize between people during emotional connection. (McCraty et al., 2006)
 - Ecological Systems Theory
- → Human development occurs within nested systems of connection: personal, social, planetary. (Bronfenbrenner, 1979)
