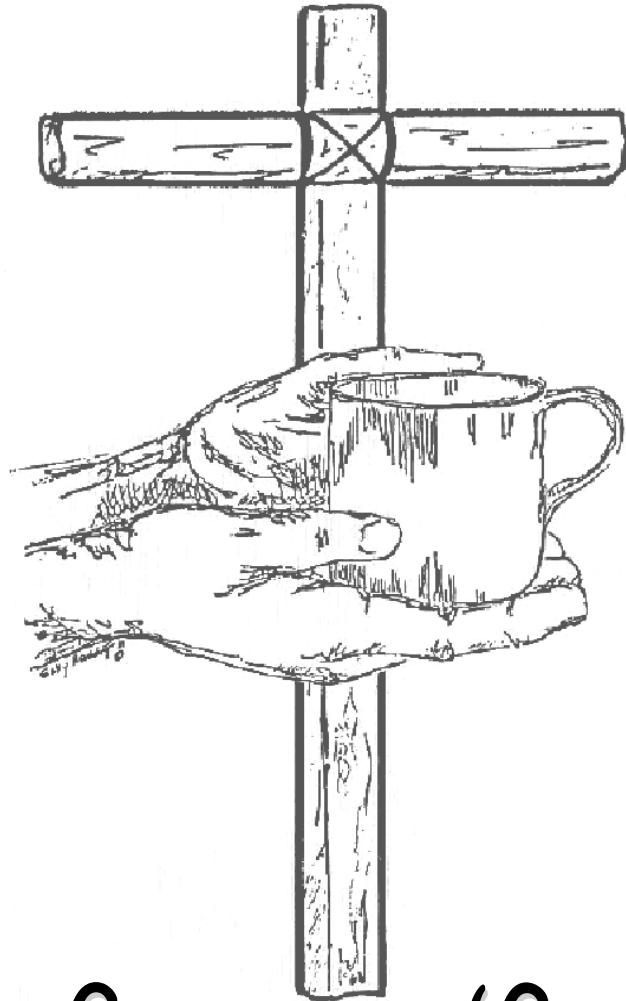


# The Celebration of Worship
