It will be appropriate for young people and everyone in the community is invited.

Then comes Easter! There is a Sunrise Service at Fifth Street, then our own Easter worship at 11:00am, led by our choir as they present this year's Cantata. I am so looking forward to the whole week as we walk with Jesus to the Cross and Resurrection!
