But the sermon is also about "Acceptance", the acceptance of what life brings with faith, especially when life brings bad news. It is acceptance as the last stage of grief, acceptance as coming to terms with life as it is, not as we wish it to be. And it is about the terrible, terrible theology around the phrase, "Accepting God's Will" — especially as it is used when tragedy strikes. Come join in the spiritual posture of Advent called "Accepting".
