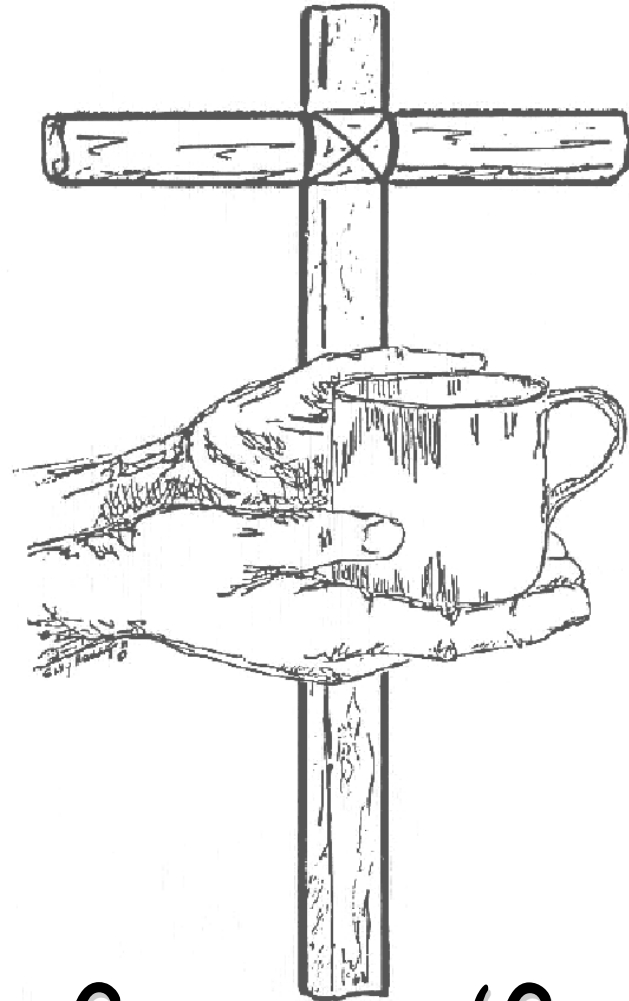


The Celebration of Worship
