Home Care Aide Application Process

<u>To apply online</u> for Home Care Aide registration, please have a credit card ready and follow the steps below:

- Access the Guardian Applicant Portal at https://guardian.dss.ca.gov/Applicant. Home Care Organizations can submit applications on behalf of Home Care Aides using their Guardian account at https://guardian.dss.ca.gov/agency.
- 2. Create an Account by clicking "Register as a new user." A temporary password will be sent to your email account. Your Login username is your email address.
- 3. Enter Application Information. When prompted for a PIN (Personal Identification Number), enter either the Home Care Organization's PIN (provided by your employer) or enter R38XKSPE (the PIN for independent home care aides). You will be required to pay a fee of \$35.00 to register; payment can be made by debit or credit card. If applicable, await Home Care Organization confirmation.
- 4. Retrieve the Live Scan Form. Print the pre-populated form and submit fingerprints with a Live Scan vendor.
