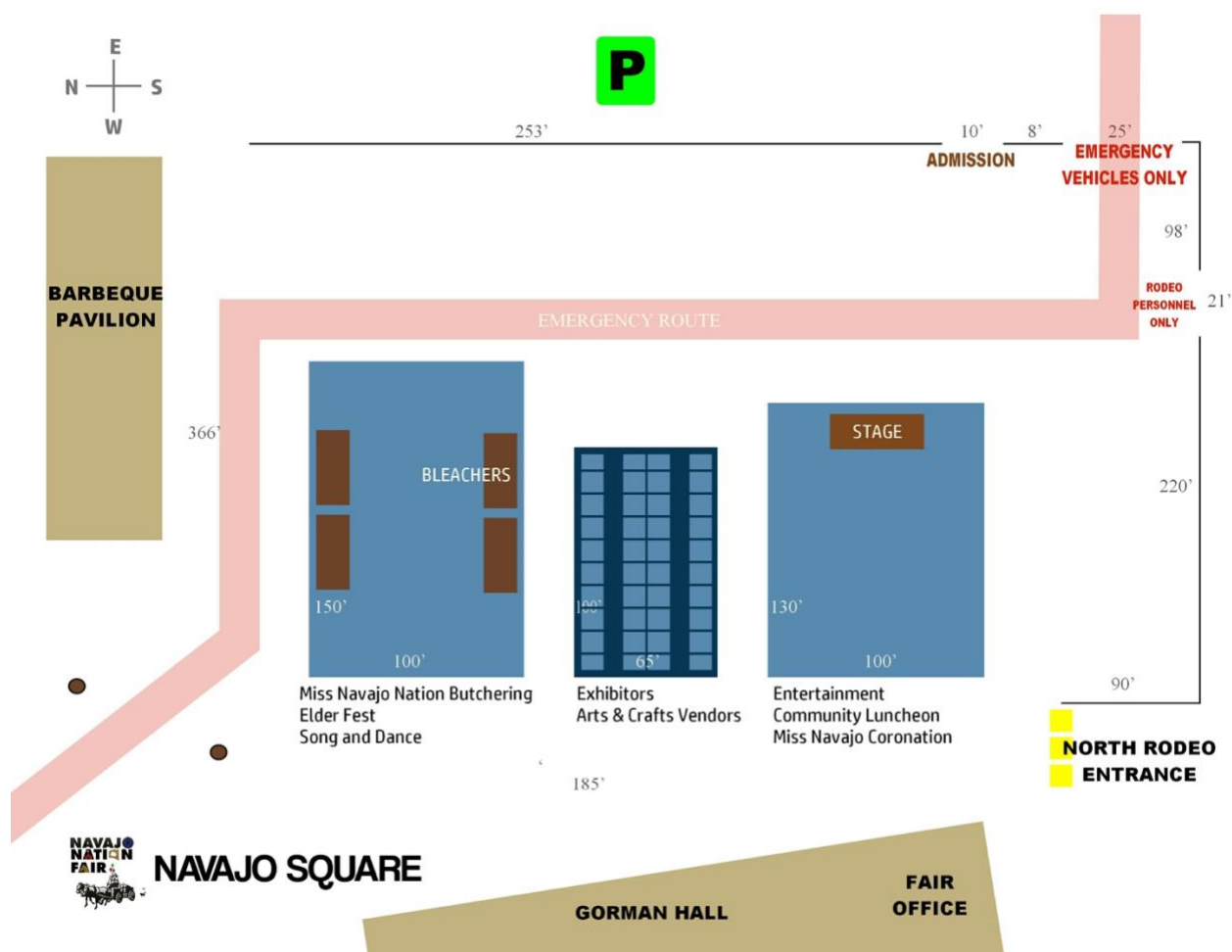

This Agreement is entered into by and between the **Navajo Nation Fair Office**, located in Window Rock, Arizona 86515 (hereinafter referred to as the "**NNFOffice**"), and the party designated on the attached application (hereinafter referred to as the "**NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR**"). The NNFOffice authorizes the NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR to display, market, and sell approved handmade arts, crafts, and related merchandise from the assigned vendor space during the Navajo Nation Fair, subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, all applicable Navajo Nation laws and regulations, and all event rules and safety requirements. Therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows.

1. **SPACE:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDORS are limited to forty (40) booth spaces available on Saturday and Sunday of the event. Booths will be located under a covered tent structure with open sides in the center of Navajo Square on the Navajo Nation Fairgrounds. Booth assignments will be chosen when checking in on Saturday morning.
2. **BOOTH SIZE:** Booth size will be 10 ft. by 10 ft. wide for all NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDORS. NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDORS understand that vending spaces are on a first-come, first-served basis, or the NNF Office, at its sole discretion, will assign the remaining space. All designated walkways must remain 5 feet apart and clear.

3. **ELECTRICAL SERVICE:** Electricity will be supplied via a generator equipped with power distribution boxes. Vendors are advised to bring their own booth lighting, electrical cords, power strips, and related equipment.
4. **LOAD-IN/SET-UP:** Load-in and setup must be completed by 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 12. Vendor vehicles will be permitted to drive in, drop off supplies, and must depart afterward to the designated Vendor Parking Lot. Vendors are authorized to park in the parking lot located to the east of Navajo Square.
*Note: The Navajo Nation Fair Parade is scheduled for Saturday morning, and the roads will be closed at 6:00 AM. Please ensure to arrive earlier to avoid traffic congestion.
5. **LOAD OUT:** All NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR materials and garbage must be removed from the event site by 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 13, 2026. A construction garbage bin will be placed on the west side of the vending area behind the NN EPA office. Please dispose of the garbage in the dispenser.
6. **HOURS OF OPERATION:**

7. **LIABILITY INSURANCE:** Commercial Vendors are those with brick-and-mortar operations (Storefronts). Itinerant (Pop-up Shops/mom-and-pop Shops) vendors are not required to provide Commercial General Liability Insurance.
8. **WRISTBANDS & PARKING:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR will be provided with (2) wristbands and (1) PARKING STICKER for staff for the duration of the event. If wristbands have been damaged, tampered with, or removed, they will no longer be valid.
9. **PROOF OF TRIBAL VERIFICATION:** All artists are required to provide proof of identification, including a Driver's License, and verification of enrollment for federally recognized tribes in the U.S. or First Nations of Canada. Vendor may be asked if representing yourself as a native artist.
10. **RIGHT TO SELL:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR shall have the right to advertise as set forth on the application. Said sales will occur only within the area designated by the NNFOffice for the NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR. The NNFOffice has a zero-tolerance policy for the sale or display of products or advertising that displays and/or promotes any of the following: gang colors/symbols, drugs, drug paraphernalia, and illegal activities. Any NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR found to violate these policies is subject to expulsion from the event without any refund. Enforcement of this is at the sole discretion of NNFOffice management.
11. **NAVAJO NATION FAIR PRODUCTS:** The VENDOR shall not manufacture, display, advertise, or sell any merchandise bearing the **Navajo Nation Fair** name, logo, trademark, or other official branding without the prior written authorization of the NNFOffice. Any unauthorized Navajo Nation Fair-branded merchandise may be removed immediately, and the Vendor may be subject to expulsion from the event without refund.
12. **AUTHENTIC NATIVE ARTS & CRAFTS:** The Navajo Nation Fair Arts & Crafts Market is dedicated to showcasing authentic Native American artwork and handcrafted items. All artwork and merchandise offered for sale must be original works created by the exhibiting artist or an approved booth-sharing artist and accurately represent the materials, methods, and tribal affiliation identified by the artist. Commercially manufactured, mass-produced, counterfeit, or misrepresented items are prohibited unless specifically approved in writing by the NNFOffice.
13. The sale or display of ceremonial or sacred objects, items containing protected wildlife materials, or artwork that violates federal, state, tribal, or applicable cultural protections is strictly prohibited. The NNFOffice reserves the right to inspect all merchandise and require the immediate removal of any item determined to be in violation of these standards. Failure to comply may result in removal from the event without refund.
14. **STORAGE:** All NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR property, merchandise, equipment, and supplies shall be kept within the assigned booth space during event hours. Booth spaces are not enclosed or secured overnight; therefore, Vendors are responsible for removing all valuable items at the close of each day and storing them in their vehicle or another secure location. The NNFOffice assumes no responsibility or liability for the storage, loss, theft, or damage of any Vendor property left on the event grounds.
15. **TABLES & CHAIRS:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDORS will be provided table and (2) chairs based on booth rental. Vendors may bring additional tables or chairs, but they must remain within the assigned booth space.
16. **SIGNAGE:** All NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR is responsible for supplying their own signage for their booth, and signs and banners must be contained within the assigned booth space.
17. **CONDUCT:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR may not consume alcoholic beverages within any assigned booth space. Vendors must be suitably attired at all times. Behavior unsuitable for the Navajo Nation Fair events or which constitutes a public nuisance will not be permitted. VENDORS SHALL NOT PLAY ANY AMPLIFIED MUSIC FROM WITHIN THEIR BOOTH SPACE DURING THE EVENT. Any artist who is involved in any verbal or physical altercations will be asked to leave with their art and not permitted to return. The market is a drug & alcohol-free environment. No pets or firearms are permitted.

18. **CANVASSING:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDORS may conduct business only from inside their booth space. Canvassing from outside of the booth space is not permissible and NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR shall be liable for immediate closure and removal from the event with loss of all submitted monies.
19. **SITE INSPECTION:** The NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR is responsible for leaving the designated space as found. Failure to do so will result in, at the sole discretion of the NNFOffice, charges to repair or correct any damage or alteration. The vendor is responsible for returning the booth space site to its original physical condition by 10:00 p.m. on September 8, 2024.
20. **GOVERNING LAWS:** This agreement shall be governed by the laws, the health, sanitation, and fire regulations of the Navajo Nation.
21. **BOOTH ACCESS:** The NNFOffice and its agents or assigns shall have access to the aforesaid described space and premises at all times. Booth space cannot be assigned or leased by any organization other than NNFOffice management.
22. **EVENT DISPLAYS:** The NNFOffice reserves the right to locate or relocate any exhibit or display where it is in the best interest of the NNFOffice and to cancel any exhibit or display that is not in the best interest of the NNFOffice.
23. **SECURITY:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR are responsible for the safety and security of their property and equipment at all times. Limited security will be assigned to the entire event site, and no security personnel will be assigned specifically to any food vending area. The NNFOffice shall not be held responsible for loss, theft, or damage to any property left on the event grounds at any time.
24. **INDEMNITY:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR shall indemnify and hold the Navajo Nation, NNFOffice, its staff, contractors including but not limited to Zion Enterprises, and volunteers harmless from any claim or cause of action arising out of or in connection with NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR's acts or omissions under this agreement and shall reimburse the NNFOffice for any costs, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees incurred in defense against any such claim.
25. **VIOLATIONS:** NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR acknowledges that a breach of any of the terms of this agreement may result in the termination of this agreement and the preclusion of the Arts and Crafts Vendor's participation in the event. If this agreement is terminated due to any breach by the NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR, they shall not be entitled to any refund but shall forfeit all amounts previously paid as liquidated damages.
26. **AGREEMENT MODIFICATIONS:** No prior or present agreements or representations shall be binding upon any of the parties hereto unless incorporated in this agreement. No modification or change in the agreement shall be valid or binding upon the parties unless in writing and executed by the parties to be bound hereto.
27. **RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES:** In the event of a dispute arising in any manner as a result of or in any way related to this agreement, the parties hereto agree to submit the same to mediation and/or arbitration as a prerequisite to legal action. In the event arbitration or legal action is commenced, the prevailing party shall be awarded reasonable attorney fees and costs incurred as a result of said dispute.
28. **CANCELLATION & REFUNDS** – Refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Navajo Nation Fair Office by Saturday, September 5. No refunds will be issued for requests received after September 5 for ARTS AND CRAFTS VENDORS who failed to attend without prior written notice.
29. NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR acknowledges that participation in the Navajo Nation Fair and related events involves certain inherent risks, including but not limited to weather conditions, crowd-related incidents, accidents, equipment failure, property damage, theft, personal injury, illness, and other unforeseen circumstances. NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR voluntarily assume all risks associated with participation in the event.
30. To the fullest extent permitted by law, NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Navajo Nation, Navajo Nation Fair Office, Navajo Nation Division of Natural Resources, their elected officials, employees, volunteers, contractors including but not limited to Zion Enterprises, sponsors, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, damages, losses, actions, causes of action, costs, or expenses arising out of or related to participation in the event, except to the extent caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the released parties.
31. **FORCE MAJEURE** - The NNFOffice shall not be liable for any delay, interruption, cancellation, relocation, or modification of the event resulting from acts of God, severe weather, fire, flood, pandemic, public health emergency, labor disputes, utility interruptions, governmental action, civil disturbance, or any other circumstance beyond the reasonable control of the NNFOffice. In such circumstances, refunds shall be issued only at the sole discretion of the NNFOffice.
32. **NO GUARANTEE OF ATTENDANCE OR SALES** - The NNFOffice makes no representations or guarantees regarding event attendance, customer traffic, sales volume, or profitability. Participation in the event is at the sole risk of the Arts and Crafts Vendor
33. **PHOTOGRAPHY AND MEDIA RELEASE** - NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR grants the NNFOffice the right to photograph, video record, and otherwise capture images of exhibitor booths, displays, products, employees, volunteers, and representatives during the event for promotional, educational, archival, and marketing purposes without compensation.
34. **SEVERABILITY** - If any provision of this Agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be affected thereby.

By signing below, you understand and agree to all rules and regulations outlined in this agreement, and NNF ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR acknowledges that:

1. Vendor has had the opportunity to review this agreement;
2. Vendor has enclosed **All** required documentation and payment;
3. Vendor has had the opportunity to consult with legal counsel if desired, and
4. Vendor fully understands the terms and conditions set forth herein and agrees to be bound by the same.
