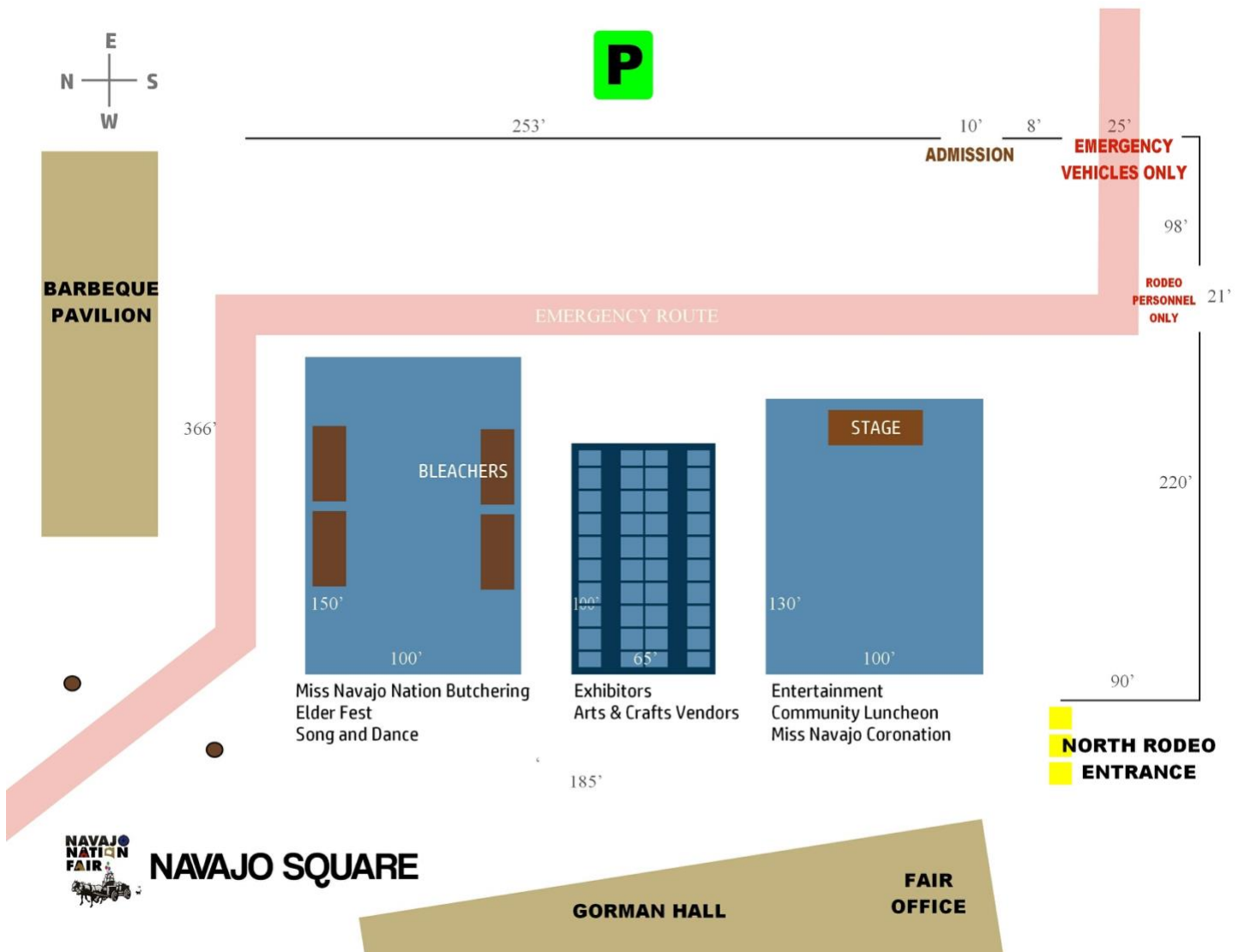

NAVAJO NATION FAIR EXHIBITOR AGREEMENT, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

This Agreement is entered into by and between the Navajo Nation Fair Office, located in Window Rock, Arizona 86515 (hereinafter referred to as the "NNFOffice"), and the party designated on the attached application (hereinafter referred to as the "NNF EXHIBITOR"). The NNFOffice authorizes the NNF EXHIBITOR to provide educational and informational materials, conduct community outreach, promote programs and services, distribute literature, engage with event attendees, and perform activities as described in the attached application. Therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows.

1. **TENT:** NNF EXHIBITORS will be set up beneath a large meter-structure tent. The tent will be without sidewalls and will be closed after 6 PM.
2. **HOURS OF OPERATION:** NNF EXHIBITORS booths must be fully staffed and open during the hours of operation. Exhibitor understands that the event will be held rain or shine, and no refunds shall be given.
3. **LOAD-IN/SET-UP:** Load-in and set-up must be completed by 7:00 a.m. DST on Wednesday, September 9. Exhibitor vehicles will have limited access to the Exhibitor area for load-in and drop-off only; therefore, please be prepared to move items by hand or with a self-provided dolly or cart.
4. **LOAD OUT:** All NNF EXHIBITORS materials and garbage must be removed from the event site by 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 13, 2026. A construction garbage bin will be placed on the west side of the vending area behind the NN EPA office. Please dispose of the garbage in the dispenser.
5. **PARKING:** After unloading, NNF EXHIBITORS must park in designated parking lots, not in or around the tent area.

6. **ADMISSION & PARKING CREDENTIALS:** NNF EXHIBITORS will be provided with (4) wristbands and (4) parking passes for staff for the duration of the event. If passes have been damaged, tampered with, or removed, they will no longer be valid.
7. **BOOTH SIZE:** Booth size will be 10 ft. by 10 ft., 10 ft. by 20 ft., or 20 ft. by 20 ft. wide for all NNF EXHIBITORS. NNF EXHIBITORS understand that exhibit spaces are on a first-come, first-served basis, or the NNF Office, at its sole discretion, will assign the remaining space. All designated walkways will need to remain clear and 5' apart. The NNFOffice reserves the right to locate or relocate any exhibit or display where it is in the best interest of the NNFOffice and to cancel any exhibit or display that is not in the best interest of the NNFOffice.
8. **EXHIBIT DISPLAY:** The Exhibitor is solely responsible for ensuring that all signage, banners, step-and-repeat displays, canopies, and other promotional materials are properly secured and anchored at all times. The Exhibitor assumes all liability for any injury, damage, or loss resulting from unsecured displays that are blown over, fall, or otherwise create a safety hazard.
9. **TABLES & CHAIRS:** NNF EXHIBITORS will be provided (1) table and (2) chairs for each 10 ft. by 10 ft. booth rental size.

10. **ELECTRICAL SERVICE:** Electricity will be provided by a generator with power distribution boxes.
11. **STORAGE:** All NNF EXHIBITORS property shall be kept within the assigned booth space. Supplies, equipment, or inventory stored outside the booth space will not be allowed.
12. **SIGNAGE:** All NNF EXHIBITORS are responsible for supplying their own signage for their booth, and signs and banners must be contained within the assigned booth space.
13. **CONDUCT:** NNF EXHIBITORS may not consume alcoholic beverages within any assigned booth space. Exhibitors must be suitably attired at all times. Behavior unsuitable for the Navajo Nation Fair events or which constitutes a public nuisance will not be permitted. EXHIBITORS SHALL NOT PLAY ANY AMPLIFIED MUSIC FROM WITHIN THEIR BOOTH SPACE DURING THE EVENT. Any NNF EXHIBITOR who is involved in any verbal or physical altercations will be asked to leave and not permitted to return. The Navajo Nation Fair is a drug & alcohol-free environment. No pets or firearms are permitted.
14. **CANVASSING:** NNF EXHIBITORS may conduct business only from inside their booth space. Canvassing outside the booth space is not permitted, and NNF EXHIBITORS shall be liable for immediate closure and removal from the event, with loss of all submitted monies.
15. **CAMPAIGNS:** Political campaign activities, including the distribution of campaign materials, solicitation of support, voter outreach, and candidate promotion, shall be limited exclusively to the exhibitor's assigned booth space. Campaigning outside of the designated booth area, including along walkways, entrances, exits, parking areas, event venues, or other common areas, is strictly prohibited.
16. **SITE INSPECTION:** The NNF EXHIBITORS is responsible for leaving the designated space as found. Failure to do so will result in, at the sole discretion of the NNFOffice, charges to repair or correct any damage or alteration. The Exhibitor is responsible for returning the booth space site to its original physical condition by 9:00 p.m. on September 13, 2026. Booth space cannot be assigned or leased by any organization other than NNFOffice management.
17. **GOVERNING LAWS:** This agreement shall be governed by the laws, the health, sanitation, and fire regulations of the Navajo Nation.
18. **SECURITY:** NNF EXHIBITORS are responsible for the safety and security of their property and equipment at all times. Limited security will be assigned to the entire event site, and no security personnel will be assigned specifically to any exhibit area. The NNFOffice shall not be held responsible for loss, theft, or damage to any property left on the event grounds at any time.
19. **INDEMNITY:** NNF EXHIBITORS shall indemnify and hold the Navajo Nation, NNFOffice, its staff, contractors including but not limited to Zion Enterprises, and volunteers harmless from any claim or cause of action arising out of or in connection with NNF EXHIBITORS's acts or omissions under this agreement and shall reimburse the NNFOffice for any costs, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees incurred in defense against any such claim.
20. **VIOLATIONS:** NNF EXHIBITORS acknowledges that a breach of any of the terms of this agreement may result in the termination of this agreement and the preclusion of the Exhibitor's participation in the event. If this agreement is terminated due to any breach by the NNF EXHIBITORS, they shall not be entitled to any refund but shall forfeit all amounts previously paid as liquidated damages.
21. **AGREEMENT MODIFICATIONS:** No prior or present agreements or representations shall be binding upon any of the parties hereto unless incorporated in this agreement. No modification or change in the agreement shall be valid or binding upon the parties unless in writing and executed by the parties to be bound hereto.
22. **RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES:** In the event of a dispute arising in any manner as a result of or in any way related to this agreement, the parties hereto agree to submit the same to mediation and/or arbitration as a prerequisite to legal action. In the event arbitration or legal action is commenced, the prevailing party shall be awarded reasonable attorney fees and costs incurred as a result of said dispute.

23. **CANCELLATION & REFUNDS** – Refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Navajo Nation Fair Office by Saturday, September 5. No refunds will be issued for requests received after September 5 or for exhibitors who failed to attend without prior written notice.
24. NNF EXHIBITORS acknowledge that participation in the Navajo Nation Fair and related events involves certain inherent risks, including but not limited to weather conditions, crowd-related incidents, accidents, equipment failure, property damage, theft, personal injury, illness, and other unforeseen circumstances. NNF EXHIBITORS voluntarily assume all risks associated with participation in the event.
25. To the fullest extent permitted by law, NNF EXHIBITORS hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Navajo Nation, Navajo Nation Fair Office, Navajo Nation Division of Natural Resources, their elected officials, employees, volunteers, contractors including but not limited to Zion Enterprises, sponsors, agents, and representatives from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, damages, losses, actions, causes of action, costs, or expenses arising out of or related to participation in the event, except to the extent caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the released parties.
26. **FORCE MAJEURE** - The NNFOffice shall not be liable for any delay, interruption, cancellation, relocation, or modification of the event resulting from acts of God, severe weather, fire, flood, pandemic, public health emergency, labor disputes, utility interruptions, governmental action, civil disturbance, or any other circumstance beyond the reasonable control of the NNFOffice. In such circumstances, refunds shall be issued only at the sole discretion of the NNFOffice.
27. **INSURANCE** - General liability insurance is strongly recommended for all NNF EXHIBITORS and is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor. The NNFOffice does not provide insurance coverage for exhibitor property, merchandise, equipment, employees, volunteers, or activities.
28. **HEALTH, SAFETY, AND FIRE COMPLIANCE** - NNF EXHIBITORS shall comply with all applicable Navajo Nation health, safety, fire, sanitation, and environmental regulations. The NNFOffice reserves the right to require immediate correction of any unsafe condition and may close any booth that presents a safety hazard.
29. **NO GUARANTEE OF ATTENDANCE OR SALES** - The NNFOffice makes no representations or guarantees regarding event attendance, customer traffic, sales volume, or profitability. Participation in the event is at the sole risk of the Exhibitor.
30. **PHOTOGRAPHY AND MEDIA RELEASE** - NNF EXHIBITORS grant the NNFOffice the right to photograph, video record, and otherwise capture images of exhibitor booths, displays, products, employees, volunteers, and representatives during the event for promotional, educational, archival, and marketing purposes without compensation.
31. **SEVERABILITY** - If any provision of this Agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be affected thereby.

By signing below, you understand and agree to all rules and regulations outlined in this agreement, and NNF EXHIBITORS acknowledges that:

1. Exhibitor has had the opportunity to review this agreement;
2. Exhibitor has enclosed **All** required documentation and payment;
3. Exhibitor has had the opportunity to consult with legal counsel if desired, and
4. Exhibitor fully understands the terms and conditions set forth herein and agrees to be bound by the same.
