CELEBRATION of THE LIFE AND WORK of FR.TOMMY GREENAN: Author of "The Song of the Poor".

Thursday 7th August 2025 7pm - 9pm Online!

Fr. Greenan went to El Salvador after the murder of Archbishop Oscar Romero on 24th March 1980. Archbishop Romero was called the Voice of the Voiceless and his death was followed by the abduction and murder of thousands of El Salvadorians', including babies and children.

Fr. Greenan died in 2020, when his stories were collated, and "The Song of the Poor" was published. On Thursday 8th May, at St. Mary's Cathedral - Edinburgh, there was a Celebration of Tommy's life and friends and family shared their memories of Tommy and how his acclaimed book came to be published. Stories from the book were also shared. We will share an edited recording of this celebration and then have the opportunity to dialogue with Tommy's friend and companion in El Salvador, Fr. Henry McLaughlin.
