

Insights from the first month of his pontificate with Massimo Faggioli - **Thursday 19th June 7.00-8.30pm**. As we continue to gain insights into the pontificate of Pope Leo XIV we invite you to an evening with Massimo Faggioli who will help us to discern what these early days are revealing. Massimo is a professor in the department of theology and religious studies at Villanova University, which is the only Augustinian university in the United States. It is the university where Pope Leo XIV earned his Bachelor of Science in Mathematics in 1977 and received an honorary Doctor of Humanities in 2014. He is an internationally acclaimed writer on the Church, religion and politics, and his books and articles have been published in eight languages.
