## Don Zink Memorial

### Division I Rules

1. Drivers under 18 must have written parental permission.
  2. Tractor must be operated in a safe manner at all times
  3. All pulls must start from a tight chain.
  4. Contestants will be allowed 2 attempts and 25 feet to start sled.
  5. Tractor must be kept inside boundary lines.
  6. Driver must remain seated during pull and must stop when he is flagged.  
Drivers of John Deere and Minneapolis hand clutch may stand up to the first 25 feet.
  7. Protest can be made only by drivers and only within the class in which they are participating.
  8. The decision of the pulling officials are final.
  9. Not responsible for accidents or loss of property. Drivers must sign waiver of insurance responsibility.
- Tractors up to 1959
  - 16" Drawbar height and 18" from center rear axle.
  - D ring or clevis opening at least 3" on stock drawbar.
  - 3 sets of rear up to 5500#, then more weights are allowed.
  - No front weights.
  - 3mph speed limit.
  - No torque shifting.
  - Wheelie bars are recommended, but not required.
  - No weight brackets
  - 3 hooks allowed – can pull twice in one class.
  - Weight classes: 3500, 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6500, 7500, 8500.
  - 15.5 through 5500, Larger for 6500 thru 8500.
