



Weekly Legislative Recap

As the Tennessee General Assembly approaches the end of its 2025 legislative session, lawmakers are working diligently to wrap up their legislative priorities. With adjournment expected within the next few weeks, the pace has accelerated to ensure that key bills and budget items are addressed on time.

One major step in the finalization process involves the closure of legislative committees and subcommittees. House Government Operations, House Private Acts Committee, House State and Local, and House and Senate Finance, Ways & Means Committees are scheduled to meet next week. These bodies will work through remaining legislation in efforts to bring bills to the floor for final discussion.

Simultaneously, budget finalization is a top priority. Next week, both the Senate and House Finance Committees are set to take up a slate of budget-related bills as they continue shaping the state's fiscal plan. Lawmakers will review proposals covering department funding, capital projects, and potential adjustments to revenue measures. To accelerate deliberation, the House has passed the "flow motion" allowing a fluid process to work through remaining legislation. This motion in tandem with additional floor sessions for both the Senate and the House will ensure all bills are heard within a timely and efficient fashion.
