HURRICANE HELENE REBUILD PROGRAM

TYPES OF ASSISTANCE:

- Manufactured home replacement
- Repair of hurricane damage to stick-built homes (wooden frame houses that were built on-site) owned as primary residence
- Rebuild of primary residence houses destroyed by Hurricane Helene (stick-built construction)
- Building materials assistance grants
- Furniture assistance (replacement for qualified renters and owners)
- Church grants for hurricane repairs
- Grants to assist with repairing driveways, culverts, and bridges

LOCATIONS:

Florida: Perry and Tampa/St. Petersburg

Georgia: Valdosta area

North Carolina: Ashe, Avery, Buncombe, Burke, Caldwell, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Polk, Rutherford, Swain, Transylvania, Watauga, and Yancey counties

Tennessee: Carter, Cocke, Greene, Johnson, Unicoi, and Washington counties

Priority will be given to homeowners with no insurance or who are underinsured. Applicants also must fall between minimum and maximum income levels.

Our U.S. Rebuild staff works with an army of volunteers to construct or repair houses to make homeowners' properties livable again after natural disasters. This is provided free of charge through the generosity of our donors.
