


2022 STAN & THELMA PLUMLEE SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship Requirements and Information (Accredited Trade or Technical Schools/Programs, College, or University)

Scholarship applicants <u>MUST</u> be associated with the manufactured or modular housing construction industry, to be considered. For example, if the student/individual <u>has a close relative who works in the manufactured housing industry</u> (i.e., father, mother, grandfather, grandmother, brother, sister, aunt, or uncle); or the student/individual is currently working in the industry via one of the intern/apprenticeship programs; or is directly employed by a manufactured or modular housing construction-related company.

- 1. In order for a student to be eligible to receive one of the stated financial awards from the Stan & Thelma Plumlee Scholarship fund, the following criteria must be followed:
 - Must have graduated from a Tennessee High School (public, private, parochial) or equivalent (GED).
 - Must be accepted by an accredited Tennessee Trade or Technical School/Program or other institute of higher learning.
 - The institute of higher learning <u>must be a Tennessee</u> public or private university or college, a junior college, or an accredited trade or technical school/program.



- 2. Student must be pursuing a career in a skilled trades and labor field which supports the construction industry. See an example list on the reverse side of this notice.
- 3. Scholarship is a one-time award, in the amount of \$2,000. Up to four (4) students/individuals may be selected. Tuition is paid directly to the educational facility, as long as the following criteria are met:
 - Must be enrolled in an accredited Tennessee Trade or Technical School and/or is a full-time student at an institute of higher learning, as defined by the accredited facility or institute of choice.
 - <u>Student</u> must notify their accredited facility or institute of higher learning that THA requires official verification the student is enrolled in the upcoming semester or program. This shall be completed in order for scholarship funds to be disbursed on the student's behalf.
 - o If THA does not receive an enrollment verification from the accredited facility or institute of choice, a forfeiture of funds may occur.
 - It is the student's responsibility to coordinate a statement of enrollment via the accredited facility or institute of choice, and to follow up with the institution's assigned coordinator, to ensure compliance has been completed.


