Come September, our first crop of ET calves will be born out of our fantastic donor cows, including Texas Undine M508 and Witherswood Kerry P113. We are very keen to see how those match ups have worked.



At the end of 2022 an opportunity arose for Boambee to expand our operation and in early 2023 it was signed and sealed. This property, local to home, is on the opposite side of the Williams River at Glen Oak. The addition of the 700 odd acres takes our total land holding to just shy of 4000 acres, allowing us to increase the breeding herd to 600 females, with future plans to extend that to 800 plus cows.

The property has a lot of good high ground with only about 70 acres of flood country, so it will work in extremely well in the wet years, but also being very fertile throughout normal seasons with its fantastic soil structure.


