As we lead into the Autumn, weaning is in full swing and autumn calving is almost over. We are very excited at what we are seeing in our herd.

We have just weaned our first run of ET calves, and what a standout group they are! Texas Undine M508 and Witherswood Kerry P113 lead the way with consistency and type. Sterling Pacific 904 calves out of Texas Undine M508 are full of data with plenty of carcass and growth. The Texas Iceman R725 x Witherswood Kerry P113 are stylish and have a lot of punch and power and Iceman certainly stamps his head on them!

We are also excited to be weaning the first crop of calves sired by the two gun sires we purchased in the spring of 2022 being Millah Murrah Stormtrooper S69 and Karoo Junior R241. Both of these sires were selected for their ease of calving and outstanding growth traits, with balanced carcass data. Both bulls are backed by plenty of history coming from proven female lines out of both the Millah Murrah and Karoo herds. We love the type of progeny these boys have delivered, maintaining the depth and softness we strive to breed. We are enjoying what we are seeing!

Now that Autumn calving is almost over, we can take the time to view the progeny on the ground from new genetics that has entered our herd most recently. Pine View Vezina J166 and LVVF Tanker 14 were two semen sires we added into the joinings last year for some out cross genetics from America. Their calving ease and low birth weight were certainly selling points for us. Both of these bulls have presented well. The lead of their calves are now hitting 6 weeks of age and showing exceptional growth for age which we are loving. They are presenting very true to type.

We also have sires with progeny on the ground again for the 3rd year running. We cannot get away from the Texas Iceman R725 calves just for their balance and type. You cannot help but admire the softness and carcass of these calves. Dunoon Recharge R102 has a few amongst the group also, and they are something special with plenty of presence and style.
