According to our Work Plan, 29.5 sites were required to be inspected in the year 2024. I inspected a total 34 sites. 30 sites were routine compliance inspections, 2 sites were construction inspections, 1 site was a complaint inspection, and 1 site was an in-field land application / desktop N review inspection. Our inspection strategy criteria was to conduct compliance inspections at existing sites that have not had an inspection nor registered within the last four year window. We also inspect those sites that have submitted permit applications proposing construction or expansion to ensure that the appropriate permit is issued. All 34 of the inspected sites are considered high risk/high priority sites.
