So according to my numbers I have completed 30 compliance inspections and 4 constructions inspections. For a total of 34 inspections. 2 over our minimum required amount. A part of my Work Plan Goal was inspecting 3 sites for phosphorus as a part of compliance inspections. According to my numbers I did 8 N&P worksheets on the inspection checklist but I must have forgot to add that to the inspections when I entered them into TEMPO.
