Jim Ritter the pastor of the Baptist Church in Watsontown told us an interesting story the other morning at the Men's Breakfast. It was about a church in Germany that did not have electric lighting. You can't get lost in the crowd.

I hope each of you will realize how valuable you are to this congregation. You are loved and treasured as a child of God and you are his light to the world. The light shines brightest when everyone is here.





We received a letter over the holidays from Dick and Jeane Weigel. Here is an excerpt:

"Season's Greetings from Cedar Rapids, Iowa! In January of this year, we moved into Garnett Place, an independent and assisted living complex. We have a one bedroom apartment with a living room and bath. All meals, cleaning, and laundry are provided along with many activities. We especially enjoy exercise class, bingo, and being a part of the bell choir that performs at various events and at other assisted living facilities. Music therapy is also provided for Dick. The food is good, but does require making choices best for you.

We both feel great, however, in August it was decided I needed a pacemaker to help my heart beat evenly. A side effect is some blockage in my leg veins, which is being evaluated. Dick's memory has minimized except for his vast storehouse of songs and musical melodies. He is happy, but requires more direction from me for some activities. Everyone here at Garnett is very tolerant of his condition and really loves to hear him sing."
