Dear Friends.

Lent and Easter are almost upon us. This year will be a very special season for me. It will be my fortieth Easter as an ordained pastor; it will be my final Easter as your pastor and as head of the ministerium. Over the years we have had some unique worship experiences. You never knew what we would do next. It was great fun and the utmost blessing to me.

Ash Wednesday has been particularly moving for me. It will a be a little different this year because we will be worshiping at Grace Church in Montgomery. Many of the same elements will be part of the service, the choir will sing and ashes will be burned and imposed. If you have never come to a Lenten service, this is a good place to start.

We will be having our traditional Lenten Soup Supper on March 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. The soup over the years has been delicious and I love my soup. have had wonderful speakers from throughout the Presbytery and this year is no exception. Doug Orbaker will speak on his work in the mission field. Doug is retired but very busy and always has interesting stories and insights into the work of our Denomination around the world. Come and eat, come and learn.

Maundy Thursday is April 9<sup>th</sup>. We will host our annual Service of the Lord's Supper. We will be joined by members of the Montgomery Church.

They hosted us on Ash Wednesday and we joyfully will repay the favor on the Thursday of Holy Week.

The Good Friday Service will once again be here at our Church. As in the past the service will start at twelve noon and last until 3:00 pm. The pastors from the churches in town will speak and the each church will supply special music. Over the years we have had many creative Good Friday services. We have had protestors, plastic snakes, and works of art. This year the theme of the service will be the "Hymns of Good Friday". Each speaker will take a traditional hymn and explore its history and Biblical significance. It promises to be very interesting. Plan on coming for as much of the three hours as you are able.

On Easter morning we will welcome the day at the Warrior Run Church. As the day breaks at 7:00, we will proclaim: "He Has Risen! He Has Risen Indeed!" Our regular Sunday Service will begin at 10:30 with worship and communion.

If all this were not enough excitement, on Saturday March 21st we will host the Presbytery Meeting. The speaker at the meeting is the Moderator of the Presbyterian Church USA, Rev. Cindy Kohlmann. It is an honor to host her. A Moderator of the General Assembly has never spoken here before. She will be leading worship and preaching in the morning around 9:30 AM. Come and worship with us (you don't have to stay for the business meeting).


