AThought on Parshas Ki Savo

"חַת אֲשָׁר לֹא־עָבַּרְדְתָּ אֶת־השם אֱלֹקיךְ בְּשִׂמְחָה וּבְטַוּב לֵבְב מֵרְבי אָת־השם אֱלֹקיךְ בְּשִׂמְחָה וּבְטַוּב לֵבְב מֵרְבי, Because you would not serve Hashem in joy and gladness over the abundance of everything," (47:28)

While not quite a highlight of the Torah, this week's Parsha discusses the dreaded תוכחה, the ramifications of the Chosen People's actions and their lack of focus on their Divine mission. At its conclusion, the Torah directs our attention to the cause of all of our ills, "You would not serve Hashem in joy." As **Dovid HaMelech** writes in Tehillim, "האחם בְּשִׁמְחָה", Serve Hashem with joy!" Famously, **Rav Nachman of Breslov** said, "תְּמִיד מְשִׁמְחָה", It is a very great Mitzvah to be joyful - constantly."

Rav Shimon Schwab offers a remarkable path for the honest Jew searching for an effective method to imbue himself with שַּמְחַה. The Gemara in Brachos (6b) says, "R. Chelbo said in the name of R. Huna that anyone who takes pleasure in the feast of a groom but does not bring him joy violates...but if he brings joy to the groom what is his reward? R. Nachman b. Yitzchok said that it is as if he has rebuilt the desolation of Yerushalayim."

What is the connection between bringing joy to a groom and rebuilding after the historic destruction of Yerushalayim? **Rav Schwab** explains that based on our passuk we have a very straightforward answer. The cause of the destruction of our homeland was that, "You would not serve Hashem in joy." If it is a lack of joy that brought upon us our decimation, then it will be joy that will effect the advent of out reconstruction.


