A SHORT CATHOLIC EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE: FOR KIDS

Responsibilities to God:

- Did I skip Weekend or Holy Day Mass?
- Did I receive Communion after skipping Mass without going to Confession first?
- Have I been grumpy and rebellious about praying or going to Church on Saturday/Sunday?
- Did I eat food one hour before Mass?
- Was I respectful inside the Church?
- Have I prayed my morning and night prayers?
- Have I prayed with my parents and family?
- Have I asked the Holy Spirit to help me whenever
 I have been tempted to sin?
- Have I asked the Holy Spirit to help me do what is right when others wanted me to do wrong?
- Have I used God's name as a cuss word?
- Have I read my Bible weekly?
- Have I made fun of another's love of God?
- Have I told inappropriate jokes?

Responsibilities to others and myself:

- Have I been obedient and respectful to my parents and teachers?
- Have I talked back to parents, teachers or other adults?

Responsibilities to others and myself continued...:

- Have I told lies?
- Have I been mean, stubborn or rebellious?
- Have I been selfish toward my parents, brothers, and sisters, teachers, or my friends and schoolmates?
- Have I yelled at anyone?
- Have I hit, kicked, or hurt anyone?
- Have I touched myself or others inappropriately?
- Have I held grudges or not forgiven others?
- Have I treated others with respect or have I made fun of them and called them names?
- Have I talked about someone behind their back?
- Have I excluded others from activities?
- Have I apologized after hurting someone or being mean to them?
- Have I used bad language?
- Have I failed to do my chores?
- Have I failed to do my homework?
- Have I cheated in school work?
- Have I cheated in games/play?
- Have I thanked God for what I have or have I wanted another's things?
- Have I stolen anything? Have I returned it?

After an examine, enter the Confessional when free. The Confessional is where we *list* our sin, and not where we walk through the examination process. In this we experience humility and the Lord's Mercy.

Father: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.	

'Bless me Father for I have sinned; It has been (amount of time) since my last Confession, and I accuse myself of the following_____ (Insert the list of sins)'

Father will then offer some advice and/or encouragement and assign a penance to be said in the pew. Then Father will ask for you to pray an act of contrition

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You, and I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of Hell; but most of all because they offend You, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Your Grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to amend my life. Amen.

Father will then give Absolution and say: 'your sins are forgiven, go in peace.' You: 'Thanks be to God.'
