VCAPCC provides trauma-informed counselling, prevention education, victim services and Child & Youth Advocacy Centre services throughout Greater Victoria. Working collaboratively with community partners, schools, police, health professionals, Indigenous organizations, and government agencies, the Centre supports vulnerable children, youth and families in healing, safety, and recovery. As the organization continues to grow and evolve, the Board is undertaking a thoughtful recruitment process to strengthen governance capacity and broaden the range of perspectives and expertise around the table.

- Non-profit governance and strategic leadership
- Indigenous community leadership or reconciliation-informed practice
- Fundraising, philanthropy, or community development

- Strategic thinking and sound judgment
- Collaborative leadership style
- Respect for governance roles and confidentiality
- Interest in equity, inclusion, and culturally safe practice

BOARD SERVICE

We are a policy Board providing governance oversight, strategic guidance, financial stewardship, and support to the Executive Director and organization. This is a volunteer position and an opportunity to make a meaningful contribution to the health and wellbeing of the most vulnerable members of our community. We meet on the first Tuesday of each month at 5:00pm from September until June and estimate the time commitment required to be an average of 2 to 4 hours per month. The Board values diversity of lived experience, professional background, identity, and perspective, and encourages expressions of interest from all qualified individuals. Previous Board experience is welcome but not required.
