- 3. Include a recent school picture

All applications must be received by October 15, 2021. Applications will be reviewed by the **Special Scholarship Committee**. The **final selection** of a recipient will be reviewed by this committee and the recipient will be approved on or before October 31, 2021. Bursary amount will be presented shortly thereafter (during Farmfair International 2021).
