Resolution No. 02-2024

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE OPIOID FUND- UNRESTRICTED

WHEREAS, The Town of Clear Lake has been notified of its pending receipt of certain funds as a participating political subdivision from a national settlement with Cardinal Health, McKesson, AmerisourceBergen, and Johnson & Johnson relating to opioid prescription and addiction; and,

WHEREAS, a separate fund is necessary to properly account for receipts and disbursement of monies received from the settlement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Clear Lake, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1. There is established a special fund known as Opioid Settlement Fund-Unrestricted.

SECTION 2. That contributions to the fund shall be the unrestricted portion of the Opioid Settlement Funds received from the State of Indiana by the Town as a participating political subdivision from a national settlement with Cardinal Health, McKesson, AmerisourceBergen, and Johnson & Johnson.

SECTION 3. Annual receipts to the fund will be distributed to Steuben County, Indiana, Opioid Unrestricted Fund (Account # 1238).

SECTION 4. This fund shall be a perpetual fund until terminated by future resolution, and any funds remaining at the time of termination shall be returned to the general fund of the Town.

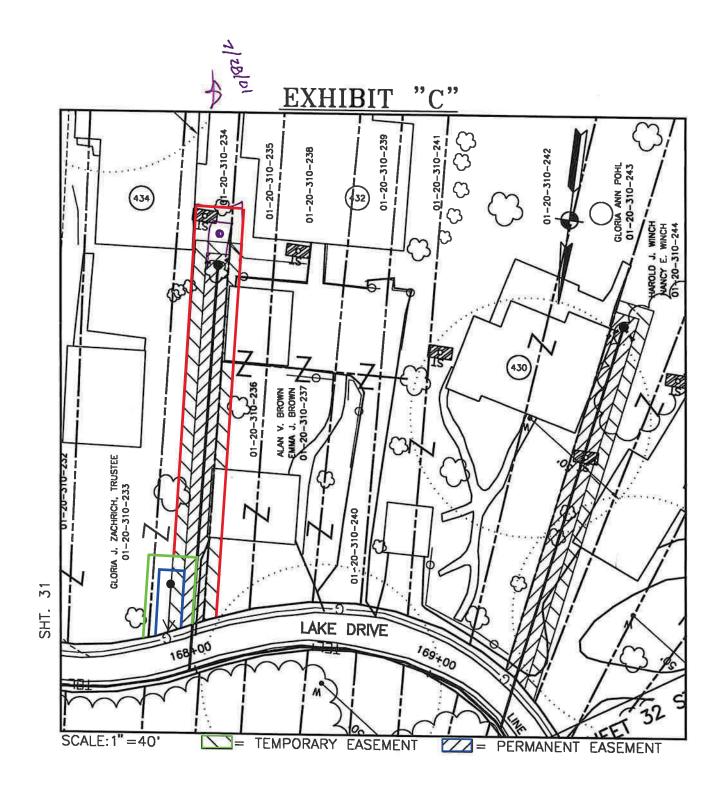

Proposed Shared Connection Plan per 51.59 (B)(4)

432 & 434 Point Park Drive - Shared Grinder

- 51.59 (C) Location grinder station within an easement shall be located within 30 feet of the edge of the pavement. Thus, requiring the applicant to apply for a new grinder.
- Placement of shared grinder (as permitted in 51.59 (B) Shared connections) will be located along the southern edge of the pavement of Point Park drive, located on parcel 760120310234000002 aka 434 Point Park drive and serve 432 Point Park drive and 434 Point Park.
- Grinder will be placed 15 feet from the edge of the road to center of pit and 10 feet from the west property line of 434 Point Park drive to center of pit as depicted in "Exhibit C".
- The Town will abandon in place the lateral, grinder station, and control panel for resident conversion to a lift station but will remove the grinder pump asset for reuse. The abandoned assets will the responsibility of the landowners.
- It will be the responsibility of the landowner(s) to pay the associated fees to the Town of Clear Lake per section 51.51(D) outlined in appendix B of the Wastewater Fee Scheule.
- If the Council approves the purposed Location, a new easement will be established to reflect "Exhibit C" and the remainder of the existing easement will be vacated.

Exhibit B Terms and Conditions of Service

These Terms and Conditions of Service (the "Terms") govern the rights and obligations of Lexipol and Agency under this Agreement. Lexipol and Agency may each be referred to herein as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

- **1. Definitions.** Each of the following capitalized terms will have the meaning included in this Section. Other capitalized terms are defined within their respective sections, below.
- **1.1** "Agency" means the department, agency, office, organization, company, or other entity purchasing and/or subscribing to Lexipol Services, as may be further denoted on the cover sheet to which these Terms are attached.
- **1.2** "Agency Data" means all data, information, and content owned by Agency prior to the Effective Date, or which Agency provides during the Term of this Agreement for purposes of identifying authorized users, confirming departmental information, or which are ancillary to receipt of Lexipol Services.
- **1.3** "Agreement" means the combination of the cover sheet (signature page); Exhibit A ("Selected Services and Associated Fees"); this Exhibit B; and any other documents attached hereto and expressly incorporated herein by reference.
- **1.4 "Effective Date"** means the date specified on the cover sheet (signature page), or as otherwise expressly set forth and agreed upon by Lexipol and Agency in writing and defined as the "Effective Date."
- **1.5** "Initial Term" means the period commencing on the Effective Date and continuing for the length of time indicated on Exhibit A. If not so indicated, the default Initial Term is one (1) year from the Effective Date.
- **1.6** "Lexipol Content" means all content in any format including but not limited to written content, images, videos, data, information, and software multimedia provided by Lexipol and/or its licensors via the Services.
- **1.7** "Services" means all products and services, including but not limited to all software subscriptions, content licensing, professional services, and ancillary support services as may be offered by Lexipol and/or its affiliates from time to time.
- **Term; Renewal**. This Agreement becomes enforceable upon signature by Agency's authorized representative, with an Effective Date as indicated on the cover page. This Agreement shall renew in successive one-year periods (each, a "Renewal Term") on the anniversary of the Effective Date unless terminated as set forth herein. The Initial Term and all Renewal Terms collectively comprise the "Term" of this Agreement.

3. Termination.

3.1 For Convenience; Non-Appropriation. This Agreement may be terminated by Agency at any time for convenience (including due to lack of appropriation of funds) by providing written notice to Lexipol.¹

3.2 For Cause. This Agreement may be terminated by either party, effective immediately, (a) in the event the other party fails to discharge any obligation, including payment obligations, or remedy any default hereunder for a period of more than thirty (30) calendar days after it has been provided written notice of such failure or default; or (b) in the event that the other party makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors or commences or has commenced against it any proceeding in bankruptcy, insolvency or reorganization pursuant to the bankruptcy laws of any applicable jurisdiction.

3.3 Effect of Expiration or Termination. Upon the expiration or termination of this Agreement for any reason, Agency's access to the Services ordered pursuant to Exhibit A herein shall cease unless Lexipol has, in its sole discretion, provided for their limited continuation. Termination or expiration of this Agreement shall not, however, relieve either party from any obligation or liability that has accrued under this Agreement prior to the date of such termination or expiration, including payment obligations.

¹ <u>Note</u>: fees paid for Online Services (as defined herein) are not eligible for refund, proration, or offset in the event of Agency's termination for convenience as Online Services are delivered in full as of the Effective Date. Fees pre-paid for Professional Services may be eligible for offset to the extent such Services have not been delivered by Lexipol to Agency.

- **Fees; Invoicing.** Lexipol will invoice Agency at the commencement of the Initial Term and thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of each Renewal Term, if applicable. - **5. Terms of Service**. The following provisions govern access to and use of specific Lexipol's Services:

Lexipol's policy Content may be incorporated into Agency's final policies⁴, including beyond the expiration or termination of this Agreement, but Agency may not create other Derivative Works, share Lexipol Content with third parties, or commercialize Lexipol Content in any way. As used herein, other "Derivative Works" include any work product based on or which incorporates Lexipol Content, including any revision, modification, abridgement, condensation, expansion, compilation, or any other form in which Lexipol Content, or any portion thereof, is recast, transformed, or adapted. Agency acknowledges and agrees that Lexipol shall have no responsibility to update the Lexipol Content used by Agency beyond the Term of this Agreement and that Lexipol shall have no liability for Agency's creation or use of Derivative Works.

- **Confidentiality**. Each Party may disclose information to the other Party that would be reasonably considered confidential, including Agency Data (collectively, "Confidential Information"). Each Party may disclose Confidential Information pursuant to a valid governmental, judicial, or administrative order, subpoena, regulatory request, or equivalent, provided that the disclosing Party promptly notifies, to the extent practicable, the other Party prior to such disclosure so that the other party may seek to make such disclosure subject to a protective order or other appropriate remedy to preserve the confidentiality of the Confidential Information.
- **7.** Warranty. - **9.2** General Interpretation. The terms of this Agreement have been chosen by the parties hereto to express their mutual intent. This Agreement shall be construed equally against each party without regard to any presumption or rule requiring construction against the party who drafted this Agreement or any portion thereof.
- 9.3 <u>Invalidity of Provisions</u>. Each provision contained in this Agreement is distinct and severable. A declaration of invalidity or unenforceability of any provision or portion thereof shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. Should any provision or portion thereof be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the parties agree that the reviewing authority should endeavor to give effect to the parties' intention as reflected in such provision to the maximum extent possible.
- **9.4** Governing Law. Each party shall maintain compliance with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, and orders relating to its obligations pursuant to this Agreement. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with, and governed by, the laws of the state in which Agency is located, without giving effect to any choice of law doctrine that would cause the law of any other jurisdiction to apply.
- **9.5** Assignment. This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without the prior written consent of the other. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Agreement may be assumed by a party's successor in interest through merger, acquisition, or consolidation without additional notice or consent.
- **9.6** <u>Waiver</u>. Either party's failure to exercise, or delay in exercising, any right or remedy under any provision of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of such right or remedy.
- **9.7** <u>Notices</u>. Any notice required hereunder shall be in writing and shall be made by certified mail (postage prepaid) to known, authorized recipients at such address as each party may indicate from time to time. In addition, electronic mail (email) to established and authorized recipients is acceptable when acknowledged by the receiving party.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDIANCE NO. 2011-02 REGARDING HOURS OF ON-DUTY COVERAGE OF MARSHAL AND DEPUTY MARSHAL

WHEREAS, the Town Council established the positions of Town Marshal and Deputy Marshal for the Town of Clear Lake in Ordinance No. 2011-02, which was amended by Ordinance No. 2016-06, and is codified in Town of Clear Lake Ordinances § 31.02 and §31.03 respectively; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2011-02, as amended, currently provides for on-duty coverage of the Marshal for 25 hours a week for 52 weeks; and,

WHEREAS, the Council desires to increase the number of hours for onduty coverage of the Marshal and Deputy Marshal not to exceed 2300 hours per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Clear Lake, Indiana, as follows:

- **Section 1**. Paragraph (B) of Section 1. TOWN MARSHAL of Ordinance No. 2011-02 as amended by Ordinance No. 2016-06 shall be deleted in its entirety, and the following language shall be inserted therein:
 - (B) The Town Marshal and Deputies shall provide on-duty coverage not to exceed 2,300 hours per year. The scheduling of the days of the week and hours of the day will be at the Marshal's discretion, with consultation with the Town Council. Any hours worked beyond the defined must have prior authorization by the Town Council President.

and

- **Section 2.** Paragraph (B) of Section 2 DEPUTY MARSHAL OF Ordinance No. 2011-02 as amended by Ordinance No. 2016-06 shall be deleted in its entirety, and the following language shall be inserted therein:
 - (B) The Deputy Town Marshal shall provide on-duty coverage and will work the days of the week and hours of the day at the Marshal's discretion.
- **Section 3.** All remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 15-006 are ratified and approved.
- **Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
