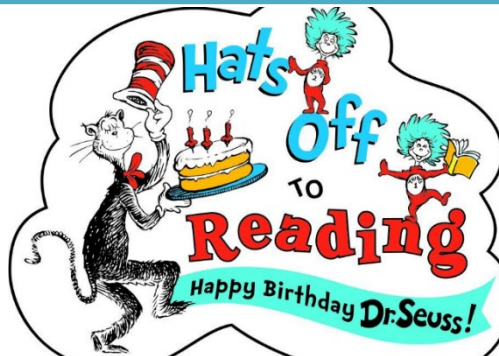

Please do not plow or shovel your snow into the roads! Also, please remove anything near the road that may have the potential of being hit by the snowplow.

Marshal Reminders!

Recommended Minimum Ice Thickness:

2" or less - STAY OFF

4" - Ice fishing or other activities on foot

5" - Snowmobile or ATV

8" - 12" - Car or small pickup

12" - 15" - Medium truck

*New ice is usually stronger than old ice.

*Ice seldom freezes uniformly.

*The insulating effect of snow slows down the freezing process.

*Schools of fish or flocks of waterfowl can also adversely affect the relative safety of ice.

Feb. 2nd – 1st Advertisement in the paper (Final Plans Done)

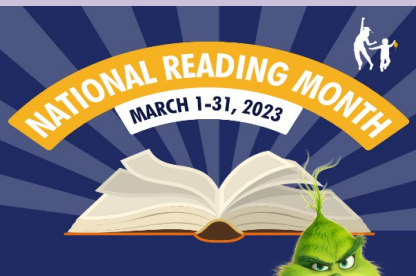
Feb. 9th – 2nd Advertisement in the paper
