

A Giant Sinkhole Swallowed A Bus In Pittsburgh

The rear of a city bus in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania was swallowed up by a massive sinkhole on Monday, making for a rather bizarre incident.

According to KDKA CBS 2 News, the bus was waiting at a red light at roughly 8:00 A.M. local time when a water main broke underneath the road and crippled the integrity of the pavement. The weight of the rear-engined bus saw it break through the pavement, leaving it in a very precarious position.

Only the driver and a single passenger were onboard when the sinkhole opened up beneath the bus. Both were able to get out.
