

2020 St. Martin's Trophy Race

On Saturday May 16 we held our annual St. Martin's Trophy Race. This is our longest race of the season covering some 20 nautical miles. Six boats (5 monohulls and one trimaran) entered the race. Guy Colson and his grandsons came out in his pontoon boat, set the Start/Finish line and started the race at 13:00:00 GPS time.

The winds were a steady 12 to 15 from the NNW (dead on the nose to St Martin's Marker). Fine Alee had a fantastic start having timed their run perfectly. Time 2 Cruise, Lady in Red and Cool Breeze had slightly overrun the line and had quite a traffic jam. No plastic on plastic though.

From the start all captains started on a heading they best felt would work with a strong wind on the nose. Not long after the start boats were spreading out all over the place.

The winds built to 18-22kts and gave all the captains an incredible sail. Couldn't have asked for better conditions.

We use the TOT scoring system, not the TOD method, so the column "TOT Corrected Time" is the one that matters. In most cases the standings come out the same anyway.
