

**Member Nautical/Kayak Sales** - will become a permanent part of our monthly general meetings. The Board has decided not to take 20% of what the seller makes, however if you'd like to make a cash donation to the club we will not refuse.

Here are the guidelines for the sales:

1. If you intend to bring stuff to sell, you must contact **Don Himes** at least two days before the meeting.
2. You should get to the clubhouse around 6:50-55 so Don can show you the table you can use to sell your stuff. Depending on how much you bring, you may have your own table or share with someone else.
3. You are responsible to price, sell and make change for all your transactions. The club Purser is not available to be your cash box.
4. You must take home everything you brought and didn't sell.
5. You can sell items before the meeting starts, during the break and for a few minutes after the end of the meeting. There should be no sales activity during the business portion of the meeting.
6. Only nautical, kayak items and tools can be brought, nothing of a Knick knack nature or general junk is acceptable.

We feel that having these kinds of member-to-member sales events can help folks find good deals and others to get rid of excess or unneeded stuff. Because sellers may not have a lot of change, we suggest you bring cash to include singles and change or your check book.

***Please - remember item #1 - let Don Himes know in advance if you're planning to bring stuff to put out. We intend to have a maximum of 2-3 sales tables per meeting.***
