

RACING REPORT—OCTOBER 2025

On Saturday, October 4, we had the annual HBYC SCANDIA CUP RACE. This was "Points" Race #4 of the 2025 HBYC Season Series.

It was another beautiful day out on the Gulf. It was sunny and warm with temperatures in the 80's, and a 12-15kt breeze from the East. We had a brief rain shower after the race had ended.

The race course was from HBYC Waypoint FR14, just north of the Cotee River, out to Government Marker R"4" at the Anclote sandbar, and back to the finish line at FR14.

Three boats came out to race. FINE ALEE was first across the starting line, to capture Starting Line Honors.

At R"4" at the sandbar, FINE ALEE was first around, followed by VENTOLERA and INSPIRATION.

VENTOLERA took over the lead for most of the return leg. All boats were pinching, trying to make the finish line on one tack from R"4", but the wind was not quite easterly enough to make it.

Near the finish line, VENTOLERA tacked first, followed by INSPIRATION and FINE ALEE. FINE ALEE tacked again to cross the finish line first, followed by INSPIRATION and then VENTOLERA.

The race was a total of 8.2 nm, and all boats crossed the finish line within about 1 minute of each other!

We had an nice After-Race Gathering at Whiskey Joe's, in Port Richey, which was attened by 19 people, including Captains, Crew and quests
