
Hi there, friend!


Suzy Smiles dreamed of giving out smiles to the world and making it a better place.




Suzy Smiles got up in the morning and began to color smiles to give out to people.




Suzy Smiles first gave a smile to her mom. Her mom felt warm and happy inside.




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to her bus driver. The bus driver felt cheerful as he started the day.




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to her teacher. Her teacher felt proud and encouraged.




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to her classmate at school. Her classmate felt super happy and wanted to smile too.




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to the school nurse. The nurse felt better right away and gave a big smile back.




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to her soccer coach. The coach felt excited and clapped his hands with joy.




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to the cafeteria lady. Suddenly, the food tasted even yummier.

Suzy Smiles gave a smile to the school security guard. His keys jingled happily as he walked.


Suzy Smiles had so much fun handing out smiles at her school that she decided to go to the local children's hospital. On the way there, she met some more people she knew.	e




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to the lady at the corner store. Suddenly, all the fruit looked extra fresh and bright.




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to her neighbor and his dog named Grins. Grins wagged his tail so hard it made everyone laugh.




Suzy Smiles gave a smile to a fireman along the way. His helmet shined like it was brand new.






Suzy Smiles gave smiles to the children in the waiting room. The children all giggled and smiled from ear to ear.




Suzy Smiles visited the children in their hospital rooms and gave them smiles. The children felt comforted and their eyes lit up with joy.




When Suzy Smiles got home, she gave a smile to her grandparents. They were very proud of her and happy for all she had done to make people feel connected and full of joy.




Suzy Smiles said, "And here's a smile for you!" She hopes it will make your day a little brighter.




Suzy Smiles told the children, "Ask your parents and teachers to print and cut out these pages. You can make your own smiles and give them to people you know, so they can feel joy too!"
