Find thirty-two Moments That Made Us Panels

The Kent Historical Museum, City of Kent, Kent Downtown Partnership, Kent Chamber of Commerce and the Kent Masonic Lodge have teamed up to display Moments That Made Us exhibit panel throughout the Kent Downtown. The panels are 2 feet by 3 feet that provide stories of America from different perspectives. In addition to the story text the panel includes supporting images.
