

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Council room, City Hall, Webster, South Dakota, July 01, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. a special meeting was held with Mayor Mike Grosek presiding. Present: Council members Wayne Klungseth, Dale Miller, Derek Sinner and Stacy Mount. Absent Council members: Toni Brown and Brian Vogl. Staff: Hayley Dale. Reporter and Farmer: Connor Handrahan.

Motion by Miller, seconded by Sinner to appoint Stacy Mount, Cade Shoemaker, Ellen Hesla, Craig Case and Tom Wagner to the capital improvement board. The board must consist of one member of the governing body of the municipality and four residents of the municipality. The term for each member is three years. The board is needed for House Bill 1245: Municipal Capital Improvement Tax, the law gives municipal government the option to establish an additional local sales tax up to 1%. The tax would first need to be approved by the municipal Capital Improvement Board and then approved by a public vote. All money collected from it would need to be used for a specific, identified capital improvement project. The tax could be collected for up to 60 months or until the minimum collection amount established in ordinance is received.

Motion by Miller, seconded by Klungseth to adjourn. Motion carried.
