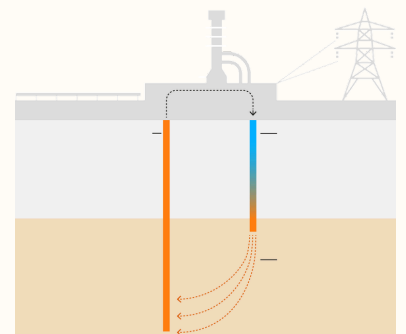

Recently, a geothermal plant near Redruth in the UK will feed electricity created by tapping into hot granite rocks to the National Grid and extract lithium from the mineral-rich water used in the process. The first of its kind in the UK has been welcomed by the government. It is thought to generate enough renewable electricity to power 10,000 homes, with the plan to open more.

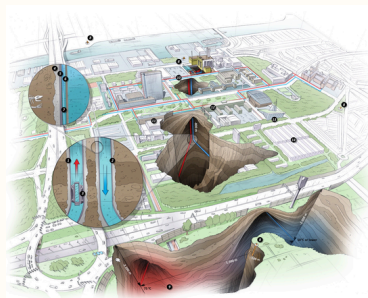

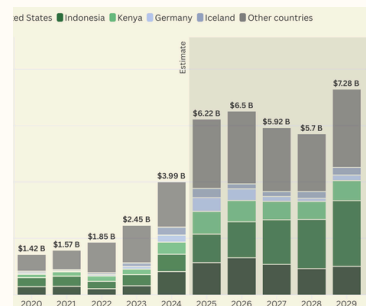
