My name is [REDACTED], and I am the staff genealogist who reviewed your Corrections Mail from February 2, 2022 regarding Harman Back (A004320) and Henry Back (A131565).

After reviewing your documentation and documentation submitted with a new member application, we have determined that your conclusions are correct. Harman Back was the father of only one child who survived to adulthood, Harman "Jr", whose will was used to provide the death information and lineages for this patriot. Harman Back's death information will be updated to a 15 Sept 1789 in Culpeper Co, VA, when Harman "Jr" sold his inherited land.

Given that there is no accurate lineage from Harman Back (A004320), all applications have been coded EL- Error in Lineage. Future applicants will need to document a lineage through Harman "Jr".

Additionally, while Henry Back did have sons named John and Henry, they are not the John and Henry who married Catherine Robertson and Susanna Maggard. Again, since there is no accurate lineage from Henry Back (A131565), all applications have been coded EL- Error in Lineage. Future applicants will need to document a lineage through the correct John or Henry, or through one of Henry Back's other children.

The corrections to Harman and Henry Backs' records are being made and will be posted as soon as possible. Thank you for reaching out to us regarding this error in our database. We appreciate your interest in the accuracy of DAR records.
