Kidlington Parish council has the following issues with the PVDP Consultation on the Botley West project.

- 1. Insufficient publicity was given to a number of the consultations, and the minimum statutory notice period should not have been applied in a case of this magnitude.
- 2. Some of the locations of consultation events were not suitable, with insufficient parking, etc.
- 3. The relative paucity of evening events meant that working people were often unable to attend.
- 4. Some events were too close to Christmas, and requests to move them were ignored.
- 5. In some cases facilities at the information access points was inadequate and difficult to access.
- 6. In-person meetings in some cases provided inadequate or poorly displayed information.
- 7. Some content of the booklets was misleading.
- 8. In some areas the information booklets were delivered late.
- 9. Online information is not provided in a sufficiently user-friendly form. Clear and/or consistent information has not been provided on some key issues.
- 10. Insufficient information and consultation on the project was offered to a number of council stakeholders: Tackley, Combe, Yarnton and Kidlington for instance.
